It is that time of year again, when the Bishop asks churches to support **Community Mission Appeal** (CMA), which helps ministries throughout the Diocese that are in need of our assistance. Last year we were able to give over \$20,000 to various ministries. We at St. Anna’s have been the recipient of this grant THREE times and received the largest amount given in the Diocese on one of those times.
