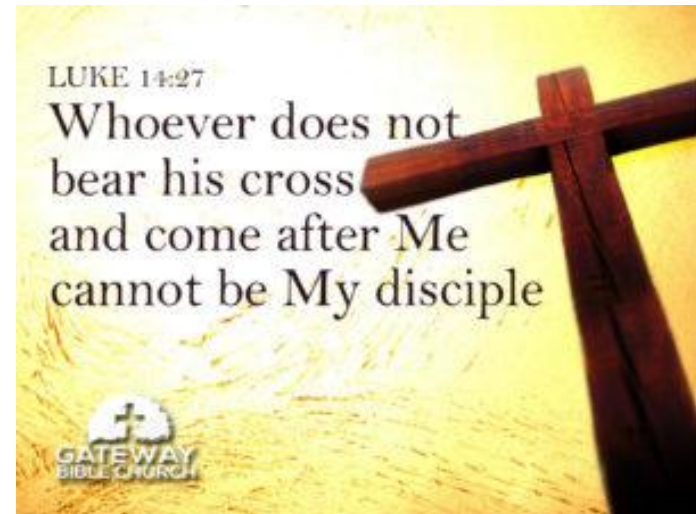
Babies and Children are welcomed at Mass. We do offer a nursery and Sunday school if you choose. One of the greeters will help you find the nursery and children's classrooms.

Community Mission Appeal

It is that time of year again, when the Bishop asks churches to support **Community Mission Appeal** (CMA), which helps ministries throughout the Diocese that are in need of our assistance. The CMA can only be successful when our parishioners take ownership and support the various ministries that apply, and are then awarded grants. Last year we were able to give over \$20,000 to various ministries. We have designated **September 15th and 22nd** as **CMA Sundays**, where we are encouraging our parishioners to write a check in support of this important ministry. Checks may be made out to St. Anna’s, and write CMA in the memo line. We at St. Anna’s have been the recipient of this grant THREE times and received the largest amount given in the Diocese on one of those times.

Food Assistance Program Volunteers

Due to health issues, Br. Don will be taking a step back from some Food Pantry activities, so we are looking for a consistent team of volunteers to work with the program to keep it running smoothly.
